* **Norseman & Vahalla pipes** share the same Shape #. Norseman stamped “9W2”; Valhalla stamped “AW2”, “BW2” or “CW2” depending on grade (ascending). Norseman pipes are rusticated, Valhalla pipes are smooth or mostly smooth with Plateau rim & shank face.

** **X Shapes** are rare experimental shapes released in limited numbers during the 1960’s to early 1970’s in response to the increased demand for freehand/non-traditional pipes. According to one catalogue dating from the late 1960’s, X-shape pipes were available in Executive (Vertical 3-Dot) Grade and higher.

Letter Code Shape Number Prefixes: From time to time, you will encounter Brigham pipes with a Letter Code Prefix to the standard 3-digit shape number. “P” = promotional pipe. “A” = superior briar grain (used mainly during the 1970’s when a 5-Dot pinning was the highest grade available. Therefore a pipe stamped A524 would, during another period, have been graded as a 6-Dot or 7-Dot.)
